

## **EVENT PROTOCOL**

## Round 1 | Imola

This document provides a framework to allow the Ferrari Challenge Europe rounds to be run in a Covid-safe and healthy environment. All the people taking part in the event are required to cooperate as much as possible and to respect the indications given.

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### **IMPORTANT PRINCIPLES:**

- The information provided may be overridden by instructions and regulations issued by National and Motorsport Authorities.
- The round will take place without spectators and with limited number of personnel attending.
- At all times all people attending the event must observe the following indications:
  - Keep at least 1 meter of safety distance;
  - Wear the mask with nose and mouth covered (if it is not possible to maintain the safety distance);
  - Wash and/or sanitize your hands frequently.









#### **PRE-EVENT PROCEDURES:**

Teams must submit before the event:

- A list of personnel attending
- A Covid-19 signed waiver for each person involved

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- Drivers' license (both sides)
- o Medical certificate
- ASN Visa (if applicable)
- Liability waiver

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## **ACCESS PROCEDURES:**

- o Access to the venue is allowed only to the people who will be on the list.
- Each person, every day, will be subjected to temperature measurement using a no-touch thermometer. All persons with temperatures above

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37.5°C will be sent to the medical centre who will determine appropriate action and/or treatment.

### **CREDENTIALS:**

- A team representative must collect passes for all team members at the welcome centre.
- Each pass will be single round only and strictly personal.
- o It is not possible to request extra passes.

### **HOSPITALITY AND CATERING:**

- Catering service will be provided in compliance with the specific regulations in force, according to specific time slots.
- o A lunch voucher will be necessary to access the lunch area.

## Team

- o Team catering is forbidden during the event.
- Simple hospitality units (tents and trucks) are allowed.

#### **TEAM RECOMMENDATIONS**

### Staff

 Teams are responsible for equipping themselves with the required personal protective equipment.

## Garages and equipment

Teams are responsible for managing, cleaning and sanitizing of:

- the entered cars (please refers to Ferrari Challenge technical bulletin);
- the areas under their responsibility (garages, trucks, etc.);
- their equipment before and after each use.

Maximum ventilation in working spaces must always be guaranteed (e.g. garage doors must be kept open).

### Grid

 Only 3 team members per car are allowed to enter the grid, they must stay close to the car and not move around.

# BRIEFING

- Drivers' briefing will be held in compliance with the regulations in force.
- Briefing notes will be distributed in digital format only.

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## **COMMUNICATIONS**

Remote communication is preferred at all times (e.g. radios, mobile phones, text and messaging app).
